Once you have received your confirmation please check it carefully to ensure it agrees with your choices for your child/ren

Please note that all of the children will have to have new consent details forms completed as a requirement of OfSTED regulations as we have new policies and procedures. You should have a new policies booklet with this holiday booklet, if not please ask a member of staff for a new one on the first day of the holiday club that your child attends. It would be a great help for us to have the completed consent forms back with the booking forms and deposits.









Trips

- ◆ If trips are over subscribed, priority will be given to full time placements for that week. Any spaces left will be on a first come first served basis from the date we receive your booking form.
- ◆ Should a child forget to bring a packed lunch for a trip then the nursery will provide your child with a sandwich, a bag of crisps, a piece of fruit, a cake and a carton of milk and you will be charged an additional £5.00 for the provision of the meal. We will endeavour to provide your child with their own choice of packed lunch but as you will appreciate we do not always carry a large range of goods.
- ◆ Children are encouraged to bring a little money with them on trips. However we would ask parents to limit the amount to a couple of pounds per child and the club is not responsible for looking after the money at any time during the trip.
- ◆ Should a child fall ill during a trip we will contact you and arrange for you to collect your child from the trip location. No trip will take us more than an hour from the Nursery.
- ◆ For our swimming during Sports week we will use Ashby Grammar School's pool in Ashby. We have exclusive use of the pool for two hours every day for the week, divided into two sessions, 10 to 11 am and 2 to 3 pm. The pool is a purpose built 25m X 10m school pool with a starting depth of .85m. We will have two swimming Coaches and a lifeguard. There will be a maximum of 16 children in each group, split into swimmers and non-swimmers. Stuart Birt from the Out of School Club is one Coach and Fiorna Cairns-Smith, a Senior National Coach for the ASA is our other coach. Charlie Hounslow is a qualified Lifeguard. Each swimming session will last for one hour.
- ◆ There will be an extra surcharge for this activity to cover the cost of the pool and the coaches. This will be £3.50 per coaching session per child or £15 for the 5 coaching sessions over the week.
- ◆ Please could you clearly indicate on the first page of the booking form if your child is a swimmer or non-swimmer.







Tuesday 9th Aug	<p>This whole week is based around the children having swimming lessons, divided into two groups, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.</p> <p>We have also arranged a cycling proficiency course every morning for approximately 2 hours for anyone aged 10 or over who are in the advanced swimming group. This course is being run in conjunction with Derbyshire County Road Safety Team and will consist of the children taking their bikes out on the public roads, with the instructors, and working towards an accredited award in cycling proficiency.</p> <p>If your child wishes to take part in the cycling proficiency then we need you to bring your child's bike to the club in the week of Monday 1st August in order that safety checks can be made on the bikes for roadworthiness. You will also need to check that the children have proper cycling helmets.</p> <p>During the week of the actual cycling proficiency Ian & Sheila are willing to store bikes for the children in their garage 100 metres up the road, but on the understanding that the bikes are not covered by either their own personal insurance or that of the nursery as their house is not part of the provision of the Nursery.</p> <p>Children not involved in either the swimming or cycling will do a variety of sports both at the club and on the recreation ground in the village.</p> <p>Please ensure your children have everything they need for swimming and cycling as we have nothing to help them out if they have forgotten anything.</p>

Additional Notes

Any films shown in the club are Certificate U and certificate PG only.

Children are not allowed to bring mobile phones into the club under any circumstances. Phones will be put in a safe place and returned to parents at the end of the day.

Any electronic items brought into the club are done so entirely at your own risk. All such items must be able to run from an independent power source, i.e. batteries, and cannot be connected to mains power in the club.

Any film, Playstation game, games cartridge brought into the club must be an original licensed version. Copies must not be brought into the club under any circumstances.

Children from School age upwards are catered for. The usual limit for the club is 11 years but children over this age are welcome providing they enjoy the club. Sometimes children over this age can become disruptive, bored or display inappropriate behaviour. In this case we will advise parents of this in order that they can find alternative care. This is a matter of Health and Safety.

A hot lunch is provided at lunchtime and a snack tea in the afternoon (Sandwiches, crisps, cakes etc.). The snack tea in the afternoon is not meant to be a meal replacement for the evening meal. Children bring a packed lunch for any full day trips. All other drinks and snacks are provided.

OfSTED

In January 2005 OfSTED inspected Smiz Kids 511 and said the following:

Our good points

- ◆ A stimulating, orderly and supportive environment is created for the children and they respond with confidence and are developing independence
- ◆ Children are encouraged to recognise and value differences, demonstrate excellent social and co-operative skills, are happy and settled in the setting
- ◆ Staff take into account children's individual needs and treat all children with equal concern
- ◆ Staff are well informed and work together effectively to organise and supervise space and resources imaginatively

What we needed to improve

- ◆ A system to access emergency contact details when transporting children to the setting
